- 1. The bidder must state clearly whether they are willing to undertake the job as per the Terms & Conditions because the entire COST FIXATION of the work is being governed in adherence to the strict guidelines as laid down by the norms of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Women and Child Development, New Delhi letter No.CD-I-11/2/2016-CD.I, dated 6th October, 2017.
- 2. The category-wise cost norms per beneficiary per day may vary subject to enhancement of cost norms by Govt. of India, Ministry of Women and child Development, if there is any enhancement of the existing cost norms by Govt. of India within the validity period of the EoI, the food items will be provided as per the enhanced rate.
- 3. The rate is inclusive of all taxes and other expenses i.e. cost of ingredients, storage, packeting, transportation etc. to the different Anganwadi Centres of respective ICDS Projects of Assam.
- 4. Erasing and/ or over-writing and/or subsequent correction anywhere in any paper(s) of the whole E-Tendering shall be summarily rejected and no communication shall be made with the manufacturer to that effect.

- 5. All tender-related documents and enclosures should be uploaded in .pdf format only.

General Instructions

- 1. The product called for E-EoI is the supply of food items such as Instant Dal Khichdi and Instant Multi grain Suji Halwa as cereal-based Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food.
- 2. Rice will be provided to the selected bidder as per the allocation of food grains under the Wheat Based Nutrition Programme of Govt. of India through FCI. Wheat may be provided to the selected bidder as per the allocation of food grains under the Wheat Based Nutrition Programme of Govt. of India through FCI, if any.
- 3. The E-EoI must be in the form of the **TECHNICAL BID** and each bid must be prepared and uploaded.
- 4. The minimum quality standards are as follows: The product should be fortified having at least 12-15 grams of protein and 500 K Calories fortified with micronutrients (Vitamins and Minerals) per 100 grams.
- 5. The manufacturer should accept the rates for each category of the beneficiary as per the ceiling fixed by Govt. of India for each category of beneficiaries per day (Govt. of India's letter enclosed at Annexure-IV). The bidder should submit the Acceptance Letter.

- 6. Beneficiary category wise quantity of food items per day is (i) for children 6 months to 6 years age group @100 gms each, (ii) for severely malnourished children of 6 months to 6 years age group @ 160 gms each and (iii)for pregnant women and lactating mothers @ 120 gms each.
- 7. The samples of all items would be tested for nutrient content and quality.
- 8. The manufacturer should submit audited Balance sheets with an annual Financial Statement of a Minimum average annual turnover of Rs 10.00 crores(Minimum) during the last 3 financial years in evidence of the solvency and financial capability of the manufacturer to undertake the job satisfactorily.
- 9. Bidder to fully acquaint himself with all local conditions and factors that would have any effect on the performance of the contract. Bidder should have experience in the supply of similar types of items or Rice and Mixed Pulse Based Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Foodof an average value of Rs. 5.00 crores(Minimum)to the Department of Women and Child Development of any NER states during the last 03 (three) years.
- 10. A certificate from a practicing Chartered Accountant should be submitted as evidence of proof of turnover.
- 11. The invitation for bid is open only to those bonafide manufacturers, having well-equipped and operative manufacturing units for the manufacture of similar items of Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food. The bidder must have the requisite Infrastructure, Technical Expertise and capabilities to produce Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food. All necessary documents are required to be uploaded.
- 12. A registration certificate issued by the District Industries Centre / Industrial Entrepreneurs Memorandum (IEM) for the unit's micro or small scale Industrial unit/medium or large scale category. The bidder shall upload a certificate from District Industries Centre/ IEM of having a manufacturing capacity of a minimum of 2000 MT per annum for manufacturing of Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food.
- 13. The bidder should have its own functional and operative manufacturing unit well equipped with appropriate infrastructure and should also have due technical expertise to manufacture or produce similarfood items of Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food as per the Product Specifications clause of this Tender Document. The supporting documents are required to be uploaded along with E-Tender.
- 14. The bidder should have a valid certificate from the Food Safety and Standard Authority (FSSAI) for manufacturing of similarfood items and such documents are (scan copies) required to be uploaded with the bid document as part of the E-Tender.

- 15. The shelf life of the food should be clearly specified as 6 (six) months from the date of manufacturing. The ingredients should be non-toxic for humans. Further, the ingredients are to be certified as non-toxic and not harmful for human consumption. The manufacturing facility has to be sterile with ahigh level of sanitation. Also, the Food Product should be packed in high quality air tight weather proof seal pack. The Laboratory analysis report should be in original and is required to be submitted to this Directorate prior to the last date of the Tender and a copy of the same is required to be uploaded along withthe Technical Bid.
- 16. The manufacturer must submit 3 (three) samples of eachfood itemof 1 Kg packet to be supplied to Children (6 months to 6 years), Severely Malnourished Children (6 months to 6 years) and Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers in air tight weather proof sealed packs which shall be labelled with the name of the item, name of the manufacturer, brand name, nutritive values and ISI certification, expiry date. The same has to be submitted to Directorate of Women and Child Development, Assam on or before the last date of submission of Tender at **Tender receipt Cell**, **Room No.1**, **1**st **Floor**, **Office of the Directorate of Women and Child Development**, **Assam** on or before the last date of submission of Tender at **Tender receipt Cell**, **Room No.1**, **1**st **Floor**, **Office of the Directorate of Women and Child Development**, **Assam** on all working days at official/office time as fixed by Govt. of
- 17. The manufacturer shall submit samples of their products along with the necessary laboratory analysis report **(in original)** on testing the samples in any Govt. Laboratory/National Accreditation Board for Testing (NABL) Approved laboratory to confirm the nutritive value of the item and micronutrient (Vitamin and Minerals) fortification. The copies of the Lab report must also be uploaded along with the Tender bid documents.
- 18. Each sealed pack of the sample item intended to be so supplied shall distinctly bear in the bold letter the following words besides other data/information given thereunder:-

- 19. The product should be in the best condition & fit for human consumption for at least 1 (one) year (in a sealed packed) from the date of delivery. The same should be visibly printed in the individual package.
- 20. The Director of Women and Child Development reserves the right to cancel any or the entire E-EoI if the situation so demands without assigning any reason thereof. The legal jurisdiction of the E-EoI will be that of the **E-EoI** High Court.

- 21. The capacity and suitability of the bidders shall be evaluated after the opening of the Technical Bids.
- 22. It will be entirely binding on the successful manufacturer to supply the products strictly in accordance with approved samples and in full conformity with the terms and conditions mentioned above and as mentioned in the final supply order.

23. The manufacturer must upload the following documents with the E-EoI:

- a. Registration/ licensing under Food Safety Standards Act, 2006.
- b. Manufacturing License.
- c. ISO 22000/ Hazard Analysis and Critical Control of Points (HACCP) Certification.
- d. ISI Certification issued by Bureau of Indian Standards. (Govt. of India).
- e. Past performance Certificate issued by the State Government. (Order and Completion Certificate to be furnished)
- f. Laboratory analysis report issued by a Govt. Laboratory/ National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL). The manufacturer must produce a quality laboratory testing certificate in respect of all required items covering the following points:-

- g. All supporting documents which have been asked/required as per the clauses of this E-EoI mentioned above.
- 24. The product must be packed in the food-grade wrapper and to be sealed both vertically and horizontally. The food-grade wrapper must be non-toxic and to be safe and suitable for human consumption. The food-grade wrapper is put in a secondary packing/ bag, so, there is no chance of any contamination.

- 25. The supplier must submit GST Registration Certificate, Upto date GST-3B Return and upto date Tax Payment Challan and PAN Number.
- 26. No payment will be made in advance to the supplier under any circumstances. The payment will be made only after receiving the products as per order and on certification of their receipt in good condition.
- 27. The rate accepted shall be inclusive of all taxes, loading, unloading and delivery charges to the office godown of the concerned Child Development Project Officer (C.D.P.O.) concerned, as per order and then to the Anganwadi Centres within the jurisdiction of the that C.D.P.O. Accordingly, the delivery of the ordered goods shall have to be supplied to the office of the C.D.P.O. concerned, verified and then delivered to AWC concerned as per allotment issued by Directorate of Women and Child Development specifically for this purpose. The EoIshall remain valid for a period of two years from the date of the agreement.
- 28. The manufacturer who does not comply with any of the terms and conditions, shall be outright rejected.
- 29. No attempt shall be made to meet the Director, Women and Child Development, Assam or any member/ officer of the Directorate to make any direct or indirect attempt to influence/canvass about the E-Tender or any other matter related thereto.
- 30. Each paper that accompanies the E-Tender shall be duly stamped and signed by the manufacturer.
- 31. The intending manufacturer(s) shall have to give specific assurance in writing that full delivery of the ordered goods shall be completed within 90 days from the date of issue of the supply order by the department/competent authority.
- 32. The aforesaid conditions shall be accepted unconditionally and acceptance shall be given on the manufacturer's own letterhead. Non-compliance of the same would render the E-EoI liable to be rejected outrightly.
- 33. The successful bidder shall supply the materials at the Anganwadi Centres under the concerned ICDS Project as per the list annexed at Annexure-I.
- 34. The appropriate court of law situated within the city of Guwahati shall be jurisdiction in case of any dispute.
- 35. The following instructions were issued by the Govt. Of India, Ministry of WCD vide their letter No. 13-1/2008/CD-I (Part III, Dtd. 9.5.2012 shall be strictly followed."The supplier is required to provide the fine mix of all kinds of ingredients including the revised Intake of protein and calories to the precise. In fact, the

level of precision is earmarked for each kind of food. The concept behind the same cannot be permitted to the demonized by referring to it as food prepared by automated machines". The procedure adopted is necessary to ensure that there is 'zero infection' in the food which is going to be consumed by the infants and the children who are already undernourished. It cannot be over-emphasized that since the beneficiaries of the food items i.e. Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food are infants from the age group of 6 months to 6 years and pregnant and lactating mothers, it was all the more desirable to have fully automated plants. Such procedure avoids the use of human hands in processes like handling, cleaning, grinding, extrusion, mixing etc. All of which are done automatically.

- 36. The Agreed Terms and conditions to be fulfilled by the Bidder are enclosed as per Annexure-II. Similarly, the form of agreement is enclosed as per Annexure-III.
- 37. The net weight of the content comprising food items will be excluding the weight of the wrapper.
- 38. The bidder must keep the fact in their mind that the quantity mentioned in the schedule of requirements is a tentative approximation of the requirement and not the actual requirement for the period involving the contract. Quantity may be increased or decreased as per requirement.
- 39. The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the EoIs and to cancel the bidding process as well as to reject all bids at any time prior to the award of the contract without assigning any reason thereof.
- 40. Exemptions & Relaxations for Assam-based new manufacturing unit (s) for a similar item, whose production has commenced after 1st April 2022.
- (a) Exemption from submitting Documents relating to past experience of supply.
- (b) Exemption from submitting audited Balance sheets and Proof of Turnover.
- (c) Valid ISI Certificate should be submitted to the Directorate of Women and Child Development, Assam before getting the supply order.

I. Schedule to the Invitation of Tender

a) The mentionedfood items shouldcontain not less than the following nutritive value

At least 500 calories (per 100 gms) Protein- at least 12- 15 gms. (Per 100 gms)

b) It should be in dry form. At the time of delivery, the product should be dry, fit for human consumption and free from bad smells, infestation and any poisonous or deleterious substance and remain so during the entire shelf-life period.

- c) The manufacturer shall ensure that the product shall contain no contamination which could be harmful to human consumption. It shall be suitable as a dietary supplement for the beneficiary.
- d) The variation of the nutritive value final product with respect to contents of Protein, Calories and micronutrients shall not be less or more than 2% of the original value using standard analytical techniques. Notwithstanding the above, no toxic/harmful substance whatsoever even at trace levels should be present in the product.
- e) The products should be manufactured using ingredients of good quality. The ingredients shall be free from foreign materials i.e. dire, ferrous and nonferrous extraneous matter and substances hazardous to health. Moreover, it should be free from bad odour, excessive moisture, insect damage and fungal contamination.
- f) During the manufacturing process the ingredients must be stored under dry and hygienic conditions in a properly-ventilated place. The insecticides used for fumigation in the storage area should not be hazardous and should not come in contact with raw materials or processed food. The quality of insecticides should comply with Food Safety Standards.
- g) The ingredient shall comply with all relevant food laws and standards.
- h) The tenderer should have the necessary plant and machinery for the manufacture/ processing of the required food items of Micronutrient Fortified Energy Dense Food.

II. Other terms of the tender

- a) At any time before the deadline for submission of bids, the purchaser may, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the bidding documents by amendment.
- b) The rates accepted shall be fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment.
- c) Rates accepted shall be F.O.R. destination firstly at CDPOs office/godown throughout followed by AWCs thereunder in the concerned ICDS Project.

d) **Amendment of Bidding Documents** – The Director of Women and Child Development, shall be at liberty to make amendments or modifications to the bidding documents at any point of time before the date fixed for submission of the tenders if he feels it so necessary on his motion or in response to a request reasonably made by a prospective bidder or bidders and he will do so by issuing a corrigendum at the reasonably for submitting the tenders by fixing another date for the purpose and duly intimate all tenders tenderers by issuing a corrigendum at

III. Validity of the quotation

a) The successful bidder will have to sign a rate contract agreement with the undersigned which will be effective for a period of two years from the date of signing of the agreement. The supply order may be placed with them at different time intervals for the said period.

b) The price accepted by the tenderer shall be valid for a period of two years from the date of approval of the tender. No price escalation whatsoever shall be allowed during the period, except in the case of rate revision by the Government of India.

c) The period of the supply may be extended beyond two years under the present EEOI at the sole discretion of the department, and with mutual consent of the qualified bidders/ suppliers.

IV. <u>Award of Contract</u>

The purchaser will award the contract to the bidder whose quotation has been determined to have been qualified in the Technical Bid.

a) Notwithstanding the above, the purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation and cancel the bidding process, and reject all quotations at any time before the award of the contract.

b) The bidder whose bid is accepted will be informed of the award of the contract by the purchaser. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the purchase order.

c) Payment shall be made after delivery of the goods in satisfactory condition and confirmation report by the concerned District Programme Officers/ District Women and Child Development Officers/Child Development Project Officers regarding receipt of goods.

d) The Successful Bidder should have to complete their works within the stipulated time as mentioned in the work order. No further additional time/extension will be given to complete the work. Non-completion of work in stipulated time will automatically treat their work order as cancelled.

e) The Director, WCD reserves the right to allocate work, in case of more than 1 qualified bidders, on the basis of production capacity of the bidder and the value of the micro nutrient energy densed food previously supplied to North Eastern States during last three years i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22.

V. <u>Resolution of the Disputes</u>

a) The purchaser and the supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the contract.

b) If after fifteen (15) days, the parties have failed to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation then either the Purchaser or the supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence an arbitration, as hereinafter provided, as to the matter in dispute, and no arbitration in respect of this matter may be commenced unless such notice is given.

c) Any dispute or difference in respect of which a notice of intention to commence arbitration has been given in accordance with this clause shall be finally settled by arbitration. The arbitration may be commenced prior to or after delivery of the Goods under the Contract.

d) Principal Secretary to the Govt. of Department of Women and Child Development shall himself arbitrate or designate arbitrators the choice of which shall be binding on both the parties.

e) Notwithstanding any reference to arbitration, the parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under the contract unless they otherwise agree.

VI. Applicable law and Jurisdiction

a) The contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Union of India.

b) In case of a legal dispute the matter may only be taken up at the Hon'ble High Court,
